Solent Feile 2010 Rules

- 1 Ages to be taken from **1st January 2010**.
- 2 The Feis will run in accordance with the Rules of An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha.
- 3 Lodgement of entries implies that you acknowledge and accept all of the Rules of An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha and the Southern England Regional Council plus the additional rules listed below, relating to the Feis.
- 4 Entries will only be accepted from Schools registered with An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha.
- 5 "Novice Rules" Basic steps as defined by the Southern England Regional Council will be adhered to for all Novice Grade Competitions.
- 6 Novice and Primary Grade Competitions **ARE OPEN TO ALL REGIONS**.
- 7 A Dancer may compete in more than **one grade** for each dance. Competitors must dance in their own Age Group for Solo Competitions.
- 8 Dancers should have their Competitor Registration Card with them in the event of a query as to their Age Group or any other recognised I.D. (passport or birth certificate).
- 9 Where there are five or less entries for a Novice, Primary or Intermediate competition, results will not affect their grading.
- 10 **A Novice** is a dancer who has not gained a 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in a Novice Grade competition or any medal in a higher grade for that particular dance.
- 11 **The Primary Grade** is for dancers who have not won a 1st place for that particular dance in any Age Group.
- 12 **The Intermediate Grade** is for dancers who have not won a 1st place for that particular dance in that particular Age Group and/or a dancer who has not won an Open Championship and/or a Premier Competition.
- 13 A Panel of 3 Adjudicators will judge all Championships from U/8 upwards. All Championship cups and silver salvers are perpetual and recipients will be responsible for any loss or damage and for the safe return in time to be presented to subsequent winners
- 14 All decisions of the Adjudicators are **FINAL**.
- 15 Any Solo, Ceili or Figure competition or Championship may be cancelled / moved to another hall at the discretion of the Feis Secretary to ensure the safety of the dancers and their families as well as to accommodate delays to timetable.
- 16 The Feis Committee accept no liability for loss or damage to personal property.
- 17 All Novice and Primary dancers may only wear a class costume, simple dancewear or appropriate attire (Skirt and top or simple dress for girls and trousers, shorts and t-shirt or shirt for boys) in competitions up to and including the U/12 age group.
- 18 No smoking, eating or drinking in any of the halls, except in defined areas.
- 19 No person other than a committee member may approach the adjudicator
- 20 Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means, e.g mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition. Photographs taken at awards ceremonies are permitted however these must be for your own use and not for public display purposes, unless permission has been obtained.
- 21 Objections against any breach of the above rules must be made in writing and signed within one hour of the alleged breach, to the Feis Secretary and accompanied by a fee of £25.00, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 22 Any competitor found to be using artificial carriage aids and subsequently refuses to remove same will be subject to disqualification from that particular competition. Medically prescribed apparatus, proof of which may be required, will be exempt from this rule.
- 23 With immediate effect, make-up will not be permitted for any dancer in the first two grades up to and including the under 12 age group Worldwide. This rule replaces the entire previous ruling on this matter in relation to make-up and fake-tan. Failure to comply with this rule may lead to disqualification from the competition.
- 24 Grade competitions with more than 40 competitors will be split as per a new ruling from the Southern England Regional Council.
- 25 There will be a separate Boys Championship in the following age groups only where 3 or more boys compete: U/9, U/11, U/13, U/15 U/17 and O/17.
- 26 Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children, at all times, whilst attending the solent feile.
- 27 An Coimisiun has rules that from 1st January 2007, that **no block, en pointe**, stationary or moving be allowed to be performed for all ages upto and including the under 12 age group worldwide. The under 12 ages group will be allowed to toe walk from 1st September.
- 28 In all heavy dances for intermediate and open the lead round must be danced on both right and left feet.

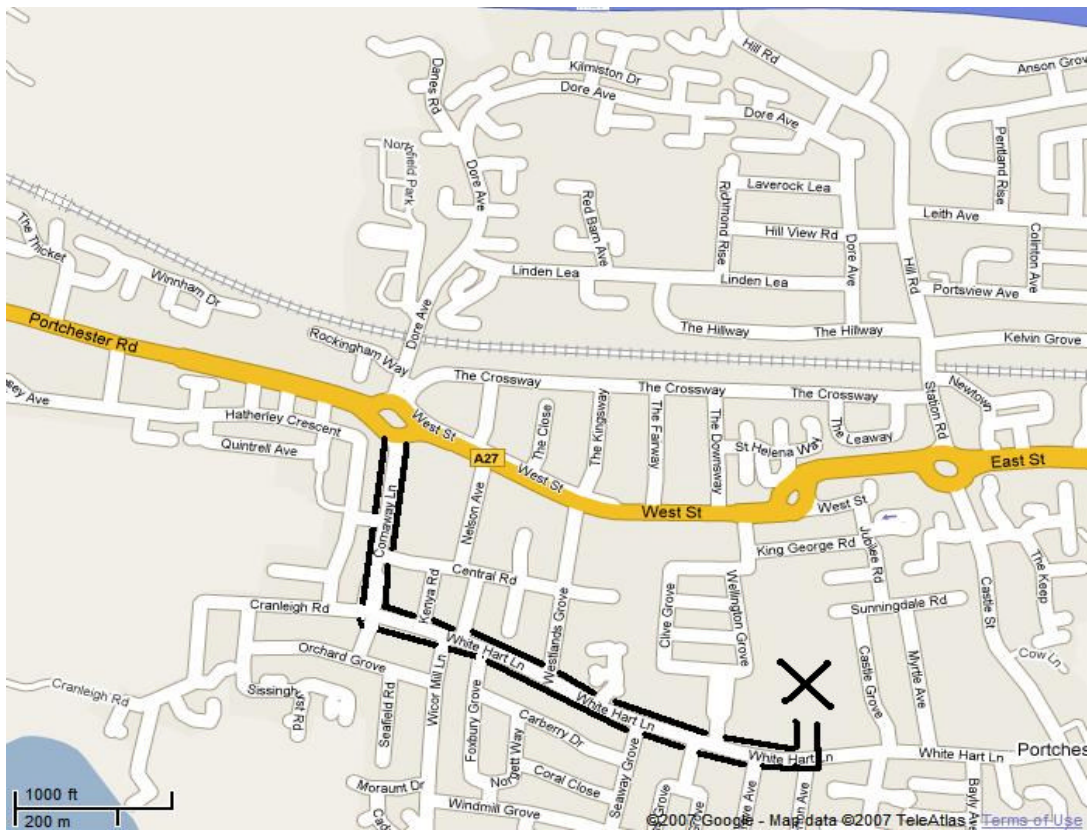
